WEATHER FORECAST:

Starting in the north, the sun shines on **Kaitaia** as usual! Morning sun in **Auckland**, but rain in the afternoon.

In **Coromandel** & the **Bay of Plenty**, light cloud & 18°.

In **Hamilton**, rain keeps you to 14°. **Rotorua** to **Taupo**: thunderstorms and chilly temperatures. **Napier & Hastings** are luckier with a sunny day and 26°. In **New Plymouth**, an overnight low of minus 4° means fresh snow but a beautiful day.

From **Wanganui** to **Palmerston North**: cloudy with warm temperatures. But in **the Capital** head to the beach & enjoy your sunny high of 28°! Across the Cook Strait, **Nelson** tops the highs with 31°!

Showers in **Kaikoura** break by midday so leave your whale-watching to the afternoon. In **Christchurch**, light cloud with snow. In **Ashburton** sunny skies take you to 24° but dark, angry skies bring heavy rain to the **West Coast**.

Moving south thunderstorms spread inland towards **Queenstown** where a chilly 8° brings a fresh dump of snow. A sunny day follows snow in **Dunedin**, 18° is your high. And finally, cold temperatures bring snow to **Invercargill** & hail to **Stewart Island**.
