## MAKE A PAPER FORTUNE TELLER

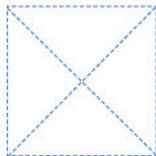
### Activity Outline

Hand out printed copies of the attached *Activity for Learners: Make a Paper Fortune Teller* sheet and guide your class through the following steps:

- 1 Cut out the square fortune teller template from the attached *Activity for Learners* page.



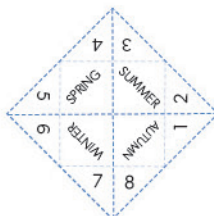
- 2 Fold in half diagonally from each corner to create creases. Unfold.



- 3 Fold the paper in half from each side to create creases. Unfold.

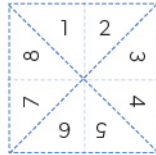


- 4 Place the paper face down (printed side facing down), and fold the corners into the centre of the square. Leave these sections folded. It should now look like this:

Turn the paper over and fold each of the four corners into the centre of the square. It should now look like this:

Fold in half to reveal flaps with each month written on them. Place your index finger and thumb of each hand under the four flaps.

Start by choosing a lucky season. Next, choose a number and open the flap to reveal a question. The answers to the questions are listed below.

#### Answers to Fortune Teller questions:

How many months in a year?

How many days in a year?  
365

How many weeks in a year?  
52

What are the months in raumati summer?  
*December, January, February*

What are the months in ngahuru autumn?  
*March, April, May*

What are the months in hōteke winter?  
*June, July, August*

What are the months in kōanga spring?  
*September, October, November*

How many seasons in a year?
